Dear Attorney General Herring,

As a former member of the Virginia Redistricting Commission and a sitting member of the House of Delegates, I'm requesting a formal opinion regarding current Commission members and their ability to speak to the media.

With the Commission's only remaining role to be on stand-by to draw any court-ordered remedial maps in the distant future, the Commission members are not actively involved in the current phase of the redistricting process. However, it is not clear what the members' parameters are for speaking to the media or in general settings regarding the Commissions' previous work.

Specifically, does Va. Code § 30-392.G or any other provision of law act to prohibit members of the commission from granting interviews to members of the media verbally or in writing, or prevent them from writing guest columns, letters to the editor or op-eds regarding their experiences as commissioners.

Your formal opinion on this matter is requested.
